Sheep Production Simulation

The RightRiskTM sheep production scenario allows producers to experiment with risk management strategies in a risk-free computer simulated environment.

It gives you the chance to experiment with risk management strategies such as forward contracting, retained ownership and wool storage. This fun & interactive simulation game will allow you to try these concepts in a risk-free environment, helping to foster new ways of thinking about risk management. Additional scenarios in the RightRiskTM library include Drought, Public Lands, and The Wheatfields to name a few. Each of these scenarios teaches risk management concepts through computer based, hands-on experimentation with real-world scenarios.
